

My Favorite Lightroom 5 Shortcuts – Digital Dimensions & Beyond - 4/16/2015

Cmd/Cntrl + Z = Undo

Cmd/Cntrl + Shift + R = Reset all adjustments of selected photo

G = Library Module (grid view)

E = Library Module (single image view)

N = Survey Mode

C = Compare Mode

T = Toggles Toolbar (toolbar @ bottom)

\ = Toggles Library Filter Bar (toolbar @ top)

Tab = Toggles left and right panels

Tab + Shift = Toggle All Panels (incl Top & Btm)

F = Full-screen (eliminates distractions, great for quick presentations of images)

F + Shift = Cycles through view modes (**was just “F” key in prev LR versions)

L = Lights Out Modes

I = Cycles Info text

J = (in Grid) Cycles Grid view modes

Z = Zoom mode toggle (hold Space Bar to move around while in Zoom mode)

Opt/Alt + Click on drop-down arrow in side panel = Toggles “solo mode” for panels

B = Add image to targeted collection (default is “Quick Collection”)

F2 = Rename Photos Dialog Box

Cmd/Cntrl + Opt/Alt + V = Paste Settings from Previous Selected

Cmd/Cntrl + E = Edit in Photoshop

Cmd/Cntrl + D = Deselects photos

Caps Lock = Auto Advance Toggle

P = Flags photo (P is for “Pick”!)

X = Rejects photo

U = Unflag (or “Un-Pick”)

Numbers 1 through 5 = Adds star rating to a photo (1 through 5, respectively)

Numbers 0 = No star rating

Numbers 6 through 9 = Adds various colors rating/sorting

D = Develop Module

(In Develop)

/ = Show Before/After

J = Shows Clipping Mask (Highlights Red/Shadows Blue)

Opt/Alt when moving sliders = Allows you to view clipping and masking for some of the tone adjustment sliders

V = Quick Convert to Black & White Toggle

K = Adjustment Brush (when using “O” toggles red to view)

M = Graduated Filter

M + Shift = Radial Filter

Q = Spot Removal

W = White Balance Picker

R = Crop tool

R (for Crop) then Cmd/Cntrl Key = Straighten Mode (Draw a line to straighten)

R (for Crop) then X Key = Toggle between Vertical/Horizontal Crop

R (for Crop) then O Key = Cycles through crop overlays/grids

R (for Crop) then A Key = Toggles the Aspect Ratio Lock (Or hold Shift while in Unlock Mode)

R (for Crop) then Hold Opt/Alt = Crops to Center while dragging crop from corner

R (for Crop) then Cmd/Cntrl + Rt Arrow = Move to Next photo staying in Crop Mode
